

- Large open plan barn or circa 500-600sq meters (for winter stabling)
- Storage facilities (for our vehicles & implements, harness, hay and straw)
- Welfare facilities (flushing toilets, electric/ water supply, temporary staff accommodation)
- Direct access (we host occasional Open Days and other fundraising events)

Our traditional heavy horse breeds are becoming increasingly rare. The Suffolk is widely regarded as the rarest equine in the works; the Shire could disappear over the next ten years; the Clydesdale is at risk. Our mission is to protect our breeds and maintain working horse heritage through education, demonstrations and training.
